

Terms & Conditions

ILC 2024 Annual International Conference Travel Scholarship

These Terms and Conditions (the "Agreement") govern the eligibility, application process, disbursement, and usage of the cash value scholarship (the "Scholarship") awarded to the recipient (the "Recipient") to attend a the ILC Annual International Conference in Oxford, UK (the "Conference"). By accepting and utilizing the Scholarship, the Recipient agrees to abide by the following terms and conditions:

Categories and Value

Conference Scholarship

The Scholarship value is capped at a total value of \$AUD2,400 which consists of up to \$AUD1,750 towards travel and accommodation for the 2024 ILC Annual International Conference and a free Conference ticket.

Conference & Leadership Program Scholarship

The Scholarship value is capped at a total value of \$AUD5,500 which consists of up to \$3,500 towards travel and accommodation to attend the 2024 ILC Annual International Conference & Leadership Program in Oxford and a free ticket for both events.

Eligibility, application and selection

1. Eligibility Criteria:

The Scholarship is open to financial members of the ILC who have a genuine interest in attending the Conference and/or Leadership Program and can demonstrate a strong commitment and potential to becoming a leader in fundamental care in their organization, or field of activity.

2. Application Process:

Applicants must complete the Scholarship application form by 30 November 2023.

All application materials, including essays, letters of recommendation, and any additional required documents, must be submitted by the specified deadline.

3. Selection Process:

The recipient(s) will be selected by a **panel** appointed by the ILC. The **panel** will be comprised of ILC members nominated from each regional network.

Selection criteria may include abstract submission / selection, professional goals, leadership potential, financial need, and the quality of the application materials submitted.

4. Scholarship Amount:

Six Scholarships will be offered. Three will be for travel to the conference, and three will be for travel to attend both the conference (7-8 June 2024) and Leadership Program (10-12 June, 2024).

ILC will reimburse you for your travel to Oxford and accommodation on presentation of receipts up to the value of the Scholarship cash component.

The Scholarship is non-transferable and may not be used for any other purpose, except as outlined in section 5.

5. Usage of Scholarship Funds:

The Scholarship funds are to be used exclusively for the purpose of attending the designated Conference and / or Leadership program, including travel expenses, accommodation, and associated out of pocket costs such as meals or incidentals while travelling to and from, or at, the events.

Only actual agreed expenses will be reimbursed. The ILC Inc. has the right to reject claims for costs at its discretion.

6. Payment of Scholarship

Reimbursement will be made after the event on presentation of receipts and an invoice addressed to: admin@ilccare.org

7. Conference and Leadership Program Attendance

The Recipient is responsible for registering for the Conference (a code will be provided for a free ticket) and making all necessary arrangements to attend.

If the Recipient is unable to attend the Conference for any reason, they must notify the ILC as soon as possible. No reimbursement will be made for non-attendance.

8. Reporting and Documentation:

The Recipient will be required to submit receipts or other documentation to verify the appropriate use of the Scholarship funds.

Failure to provide requested documentation may result in the Recipient forfeiting all or part of the Scholarship funds.

8. Publicity and Promotion:



By accepting the Scholarship, the Recipient grants the ILC the right to use their name, likeness, and any information provided in the application for promotional purposes without further compensation.

9. Termination of Scholarship:

The ILC Inc reserves the right to terminate the Scholarship if the Recipient fails to comply with these terms and conditions or engages in any behavior deemed unacceptable or unethical.

10. Governing Law:

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of South Australia, without regard to its conflict of laws or principles.

11. Modification of Terms:

The ILC Inc reserves the right to modify these terms and conditions at any time. Recipients will be notified of any changes in writing.

12. Entire Agreement:

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior agreements and understandings, whether oral or written.

By accepting the Scholarship, the Recipient acknowledges that they have read and understood these Terms and Conditions and agree to abide by them. Violation of any of these terms may result in the forfeiture of the Scholarship and any associated funds.
