
THE FRAMEWORK

ILC ANNUAL INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE

The ILC Annual International Conference is the key annual event for the ILC and brings together our global community of fundamental care experts and champions from practice, research, education and policy.

The event is held in June each year and in 2025 the conference will be held in Genoa, Italy.

LEADERSHIP & MENTORING PROGRAM - LAMP

The FoC Leadership & Mentoring Program will empower you to challenge and change how fundamentals of care is valued, prioritised, and actioned within your organisation.

ILC LAMPs are run every year immediately following the annual conference. Up to four LAMPs may be run each year across our three regions.

The 2023/24 year was a significant one for the ILC. Since incorporation in November 2022, the ILC has:

- Established new governance structures and systems:
 - Management Committee elected in June 2023
 - Strategy & Policy Forum established and operational
 - Regional Networks established and functioning
 - Special Interest Groups Research, Education established and functioning
- Established financial systems, banking and accounting policies and procedures
- Successfully ran a conference in the United States Portland, Maine hosted by
- Founding Partner Maine Medical Centre
- Successfully presented two Leadership and Mentoring Program (LAMP) Intensive Workshops
 in Portland Maine, and in Adelaide, with the Adelaide workshop sold out.
- Awarded three scholarships to the Portland Maine conference.
- Signed on Uppsala Universitet as the sixth Founding Partner to invest in the ILC Development Fund, with negotiations well advanced to have Health New Zealand join as the seventh and final Founding Partner.
- Published the Maine Statement in the Journal of Advanced Nursing January 2024.
- Updated and launched a new website and membership database November 2023.
